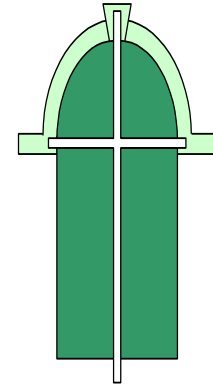

made, nor deriving any glory from them, but only displaying His own glory in, by, to, and upon them. He is the only fountain of all being, of whom, through whom, and to whom are all things and has most sovereign dominion over them, to do by them, for them, or upon them whatever pleases Him. In His sight all things are open and known, His knowledge is infinite, infallible, and independent of the creature, so as nothing is to Him contingent, or uncertain. He is most holy in all His counsels, in all His works, and in all His commands. To Him is due from angels and men, and every other creature, whatever worship, service, or obedience He is pleased to require of them.
