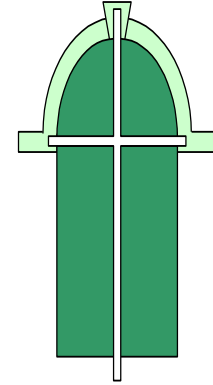

By this ministry people are called to repentance and faith in Christ crucified. For 'how shall they believe in him of whom they have not heard? And how shall they hear without someone preaching? And how shall they preach unless they have been sent?

Leader: Let us now together confess our sins before our merciful God:

All: Father, you have said that we are ambassadors for Christ, imploring through Him for people to be reconciled to you. Forgive us for our frequent timidity, our countless excuses, our failures to boldly love, and our opportunities wasted. You tell us to always be prepared to make a defense to anyone who asks us for our reason for our hope that is in you, forgive us for our failures to prepare and pray. Father God, we are hesitating, and often unwilling witnesses; yet we long to bring life and hope to others in Christ. Forgive us our sins, and give us a greater confidence in the power of the Gospel to change hearts, transform minds, and subdue wills! We ask because Christ Jesus has called us to Himself, and called us to His service, and we pray these things in Christ's name. Amen.
