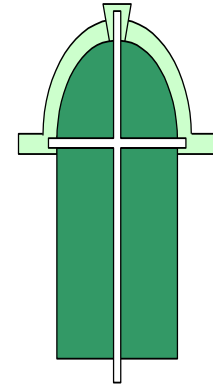

Leader: Let us declare together what we believe the Word of God teaches: What do you believe about the church of Jesus Christ:

All: The visible Church, which is also catholic or universal under the Gospel (not confined to one nation, as before under the law), consists of all those throughout the world who profess the true religion; and of their children: and is the kingdom of the Lord Jesus Christ, the house and family of God, out

of which there is no ordinary possibility of salvation. To this catholic visible Church, Christ has given the ministry, Scriptures, and means of grace of God, for the gathering and maturing of the saints, in this life, to the end of the world: and does, by His own presence and Spirit, according to His promise, make them effectual to the saints.

Corporate Confession of Sin*

Leader: Let us now seek again the mercy of our God, by confessing together our sins:

All: Eternal God, we confess that often we have failed to be an obedient church: we have not done your will; we have broken your law; we have rebelled against your love; we have not loved our neighbors; we have not heard the cry of the needy.
