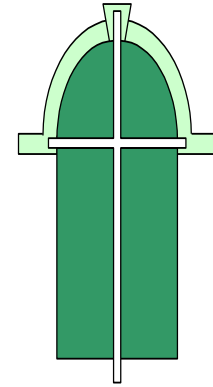

† **Confession of Faith** The Westminster Confession of Faith
Ch. 14, Sec. 2

Leader: Let us declare together what we believe the Scriptures teach. What do you believe about saving faith in Christ?

All: By this faith, a Christian believes to be true whatever is revealed in the Word, for the authority of God Himself speaking in it; and acts differently on that which each particular passage of it contains; yielding obedience to the commands, trembling at the warnings, and embracing the promises of God for this life, and that which is to come. But the principal acts of saving faith are accepting, receiving, and resting on Christ alone for justification, sanctification, and eternal life, by virtue of the covenant of grace.

Corporate Confession of Sin*

Leader: Let us now express our need for the Gospel, and our hope in the covenant of grace, as we confess our sins before our holy and merciful God:

All: O my Savior, help me. I am slow to learn, prone to forget, and weak to climb; I am in the foothills when I should be on the heights; I am pained by my graceless heart, my prayerless days, my poverty of love, my sloth in the heavenly race, my sullied conscience, my wasted hours, my unspent opportunities. I am blind while the light shines around me: take the scales from my eyes, grind to dust my heart of unbelief. Make it my highest joy to study you, meditate on you, gaze on you, sit like Mary at your feet, lean like John on your breast, appeal like Peter to your love, count like Paul all things but dung. I believe, help my unbelief. In Christ's name. Amen

Promise of Pardoning Grace Titus 3:4-7

Leader: But when the goodness and loving kindness of God our Savior appeared, he saved us, not because of works done by us in righteousness, but according to his own mercy, by the washing of regeneration and renewal of the Holy Spirit, whom he poured out on us richly through Jesus Christ our Savior, so that being justified by his grace we might become heirs according to the hope of eternal life.
