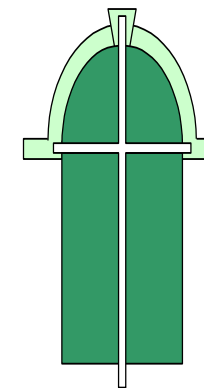

† **Confession of Faith** The Westminster Confession of Faith
Ch. VI, Sec. 5

Leader: Let us confess together what we believe the Scriptures teach. Having been called, regenerated, justified, and adopted by Christ, do Christians still sin?

All: The corruption of nature, during this life, doth remain in those that are regenerated; and although it be, through Christ, pardoned and mortified; yet both itself, and all the motions thereof, are truly and properly sin.

Corporate Confession of Sin*

Leader: Recognizing that we still sin daily in word, thought and deed, let us go to our holy and merciful God seeking His assurance and pardon through Christ:

All: Almighty God, we come before you today to proclaim that you are excellent and that your glory is evident in all of creation. You are holy and perfect in all your ways, yet you stoop to love us, fallen and sinful rebels that we are...We admit before you that we often find it difficult to live in community with one another as you call us to. We are judgmental towards others...We frequently struggle with malice, hypocrisy, envy, deceit, and slander. Though at times we may control our tongues, in our minds we rehearse endlessly the sins and weaknesses of others, as we try to justify ourselves and feel superior... Father, forgive us for the many sins that we commit each and every day. We cast ourselves on your mercy and thank you for the blood of Christ, which cleanses us from all sin, and for the obedience of Christ, which replaces our record of rebellion with the glory of his perfect holiness...Holy Spirit of the Living God...May your great and mighty power, which raised Christ from the dead, be strongly at work in each of us, helping us to love one another with powerful gratitude and to live lives of increasing holiness, purity, and love for you and for one another. In the excellent name of Jesus Christ we pray. Amen.
