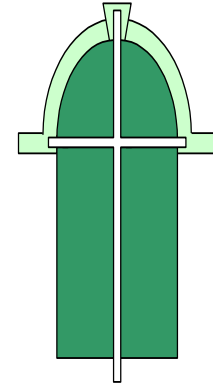
**Theme: What is our hope when God seems silent in the face
