III. Remember to Trust the Promises of God's Word (v. 21-26)

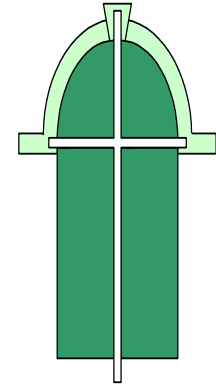
