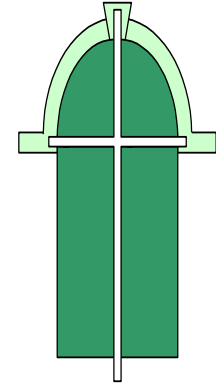

**Leader:** All your works shall give thanks to you, O LORD, and all your saints shall bless you! They shall speak of the glory of your kingdom and tell of your power, to make known to the children of man your mighty deeds, and the glorious splendor of your kingdom. Your kingdom is an everlasting kingdom, and your dominion endures throughout all generations.

**People:** The LORD is faithful in all his words and kind in all his works. The LORD upholds all who are falling and raises up all who are bowed down.

**Leader:** The eyes of all look to you, and you give them their food in due season. You open your hand; you satisfy the desire of every living thing. **All:** "Give us this day our daily bread" means: Do take care of all our physical needs so that we come to know that you are the only source of everything good, and that neither our work and worry nor your gifts can do us any good without your blessing. And so help us to give up our trust in creatures and to put trust in you alone.

**Leader:** We come into the holy presence of God, who knows the innermost thoughts of our hearts and minds, and sees all our deeds. Therefore, in confession of sin, we acknowledge what He already knows, and we seek the mercy He freely offers through Jesus Christ. So let us together sing our confession of sin:
