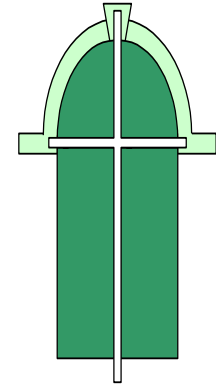

**Leader:** Let us declare together what we believe the Scriptures teach. What happened to man in the fall away from God?

**All:** Man was created in the beginning in the image of God. He was adorned with complete holiness. In his mind he had the true and wholesome knowledge of his Creator and spiritual realities. In his will and heart he

had righteousness, and in all his affections he had purity. But when he fell away from God by the instigation of the devil and by his own free will, he deprived himself of these excellent gifts. In contrast to the gifts given at creation, he caused in his mind blindness, horrible darkness, vanity, and perverseness of judgment, in his will and heart wickedness, rebellion, and hardness, and in all his affections impurity.
