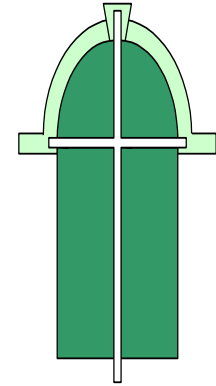

Leader: What do the Scriptures principally teach?

All: The Scriptures principally teach, what man is to believe concerning God, and what duty God requires of man.

Corporate Confession of Sin*

Leader: Let us confess our sin and foolishness to our God, and seek His mercy.

All: “Our wise and loving Father, we admit to you our foolishness and habitual blindness to your will. We often believe we are wiser and more loving than you are, and we try to use prayer to manipulate you into doing what we want. We are full of turmoil and anxiety because we do not trust in your wisdom or believe that all your ways are best for us...Although we claim to believe in you and fear you, we spend most of our days living as though you do not exist...Father, forgive us our functional atheism. Thank you for loving profoundly loving and foolish and sinful rebels like us. You sent your cherished Son to live among blind and evil people so that we could be rescued from our foolish depravity...Please soften our hard hearts and open our blind eyes more each day. Help us to see our sin clearly, to see you clearly, and to long to grow in wisdom...Keep us near the cross, always needy and looking to you for mercy and hope.” In Christ’s name. Amen.
