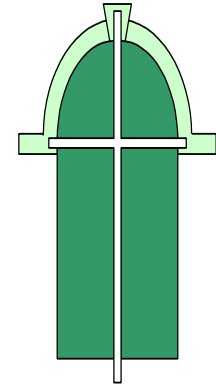
Theme: The Resurrection encourages us to endure for Christ and for the glory He promises!

Leader: On this Resurrection Sunday, let us together profess what we joyfully believe the Scriptures teach us: How does Christ's resurrection benefit us?

All: First, by his resurrection he has overcome death, so that he might make us share in the righteousness he won for us by his death. Second, by his power we too are already now resurrected to a new life. Third, Christ's resurrection is a guarantee of our glorious resurrection.

Confession of Sin*

Leader: Since Christ's resurrection is the confirmation of our forgiveness, our power for new life, and our hope for the future, let us with both confidence and sorrow, confess our sins together before our risen Lord.

All: Almighty God, you have raised Jesus from the grave and crowned him Lord of all. We confess that we have not bowed before him or acknowledged his rule in our lives. We have gone along with the way of the world and failed to give him glory. Forgive us and raise us from our sin, that we may be your faithful people, obeying the commands of our Lord Jesus Christ, who rules the world and is head of the church, his body. Amen.
