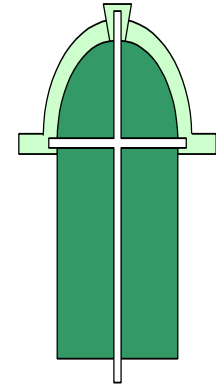

Leader: Let us confess together what we believe:  
Which is the third commandment?

All: The third commandment is, 'Thou shalt not take the name of the LORD thy God in vain: for the LORD will not hold him guiltless that taketh His name in vain.'

Leader: What is the reason annexed to the third commandment?

All: The reason annexed to the third commandment is, that however the breakers of this commandment may escape punishment from men, yet the LORD our God will not suffer them to escape His righteous judgment.

Corporate Confession of Sin\* ..... Ps. 8:1; Mt. 6:9; Ex. 20:7; Phil. 2:9

Leader: Let us confess our sins together before our God:

All: 'O LORD, our Lord, how majestic is your name in all the earth!' We confess that we have sinned against you and this third commandment. We have spoken your name lightly. We have slandered it with our lips and our lives. Forgive us, Lord. We repent of this sin of irreverence. Teach us to reverently use your name in thought, word, and deed. We pray this in 'the name that is above very name,' even Jesus Christ the Lord. Amen.
