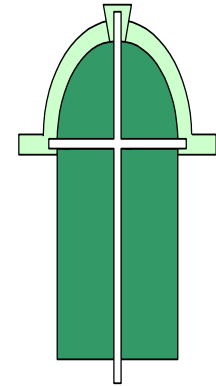

Leader: What do we believe about God's wisdom?

Leader: How are we to respond to God's wisdom?

All: The fear of the Lord is the beginning of knowledge and instruction; Choose my [wisdom] instruction instead of silver, knowledge rather than choice gold, for *wisdom* is more precious than rubies, and nothing you desire can compare with her.

Corporate Confession of Sin

Leader: Let us confess our sins together before the Lord, crying out for His mercy through Jesus Christ:

All: Father your understanding is beyond us and you are good to share your wisdom with us. You have not withheld any thing we need for knowing you and knowing how to follow you, yet we foolishly neglect your wisdom. We confess to not living by the wisdom you give but instead following our own false wisdom, and following the false wisdom of this world, and following the false wisdom of Satan. Help us by your mercy and the Spirit to live according to your wisdom.
