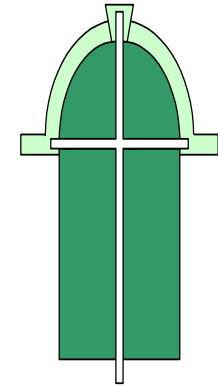
**SERMON SERIES: 1 SAMUEL: WHO WILL BE KING?
 “COUNTERFEIT REPENTANCE AND A HOLY GOD”
 SCRIPTURE READING: 1 Samuel 6:1-7:2**

Theme: As sinners before a Holy God, do we know what genuine Biblical repentance looks like?

I. Genuine repentance means more than giving restitution or seeking relief from consequences. (v. 1-12)

II. Genuine repentance is a turning away from sin in recognition of God’s holiness and glory. (v. 13- 7:2)

Leader: Let us confess together what we believe the Scriptures teach: What is repentance unto life?

All: Repentance unto life is a saving grace, wrought in the heart of a sinner by the Spirit and Word of God, whereby, out of sight and sense, not only of the danger, but also of the filthiness and odiousness of his sins, and upon the apprehension of God's mercy in Christ to such as are penitent, he so grieves and hates his sins, as that he turns from them all to God, purposing and endeavoring constantly to walk with him in all the ways of new obedience.

Corporate Confession of Sin*

Leader: Let us now, in repentance and faith, confess our sins to our holy and merciful God:

All: Lord, forgive us, for we live as if we had been delivered to work wickedness. We cannot sin at so cheap a rate as others do. We pray thee humble us under our great and grievous sins. Give us repentance unto salvation and a lively faith through the blood of Jesus Christ. Quick-en our graces, forgive our sins, make alive our souls. Let us be such as thou wilt have us to be. Make us Christians not only by outward profession, but an inward heart-experience, that we may live in heaven while we are on earth and come to heaven when we shall leave the earth...All for Jesus Christ's sake, to whom with thy blessed self and Spirit be all glory and honour, Amen.
