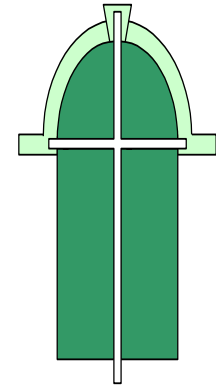
**SERMON SERIES: I SAMUEL: WHO WILL BE KING?
