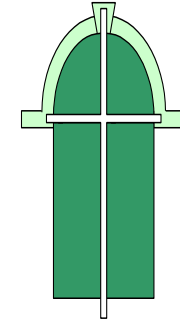
**SCRIPTURE READING: James 4:1-12**
