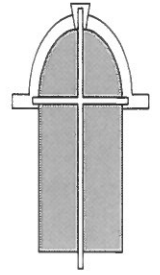

Meditation in Preparation for Worship

† Call to Worship 1 Chronicles 16:8-10

Leader: Let us now call ourselves to rightly worship our maker and sustainer with all our heart, mind, soul, and strength.

All: "Oh give thanks to the Lord; call upon his name; make known his deeds among the peoples! Sing to him, sing praises to him; tell of all his wondrous works! Glory in his holy name; let the hearts of those who seek the Lord rejoice!"

Leader: Father, we are desperate for you to align our hearts to You. Come and help us so that we may honor you. You have sought us in our weakness and for that we want to magnify your strength. Come, be adored Lord, for you are worthy. Amen.

† Confession of Faith

Leader: Let us pray as our Savior taught us...

All: Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name; your kingdom come; your will be done; on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread. And forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us. And lead us not into temptation; but deliver us from evil. For yours is the kingdom, the power, and the glory, for ever and ever. Amen.

Confession of Sin

Leader: Let us agree with God that we have broken His good commands to love our neighbors.

All: Father we confess that our eyes are not fixed on the return of your Son. We have fixated on many things but not the hope of seeing Jesus reigning. We confess to misusing the wealth you have supplied us with because we are more worldly-minded than eternally-minded. We confess that we have not persevered with patient expectation for Jesus' return but have become preoccupied by our wants and fears. We also confess to grumbling against one-another far more than we have sought to build one-another up until that day. Please forgive us. Give us confidence that you are with us. Give us unity of steadfast love. Finally give us a consuming fixation on our King's triumphant return.

Moment for Silent Confession of Personal Sin

Take time to silently confess your sin to God who hears the lowly.

Assurance of Pardon Romans 5:6 and 10

Leader: For while we were still weak, at the right time Christ died for the ungodly.... For if while we were enemies we were reconciled to God by the death of his Son, **much more**, now that we are reconciled, shall we be saved by his life.

Prayers of the Church

Some ideas for this week: Pray for our church to offer gospel refuge to the scared, hungry, tired, weak, abused, and neglected. Pray for your neighbors needs. Pray for the wealth you/we do have to not be a hindrance to following Jesus. Pray for an eternal perspective at all times.

“FOLLOWING JOB’S EXAMPLE” - Scripture Reading: James 5:1-12

Theme: Since God Will Right Every Wrong, We Can Patiently Endure Oppression
