- Learn verses from the attached list to earn points. See shortened verses on page 5 for preschoolers. You may use any translation but we prefer that you learn the version (ESV) shown on the sheet so that we all learn them the same way.
- Say the verse to a listener. This can be a parent or any adult. We will not have listeners at church this year at least through June. We will let you know if we are able to add listeners later. The listener or a parent must initial the verse on your sheet for you to get credit. The last day to say verses will be August 9th.
- Get a small prize immediately when you say a verse. Kids will also receive a Wendy's Frosty Tag when you earn your first 25 points. Glenda will contact you throughout the summer to see what verses you have learned so far & get the weekly prizes to you.
- Redeem your points at the end of summer at Memory Market or something similar. More details later

- Families: Work on learning one of the passages together.
- We hope to have a Scripture Memory Celebration in August. Watch for announcement with more details.
